Building the Future with Contract Finishing

Contract hog finishing by definition is a business venture in which two or more parties share the risks, rewards, and responsibilities of producing market hogs. Contract production offers farm operations an income opportunity with more quantifiable risks than other farm business opportunities. When contracting with The Maschhoffs, price and production risk are assumed by the company. Contract finishing is generally considered to be lower risk than non-contract production and is generally more favorable to lenders.

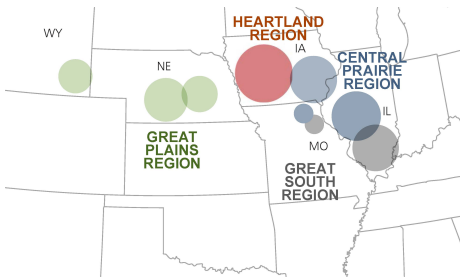

Partnering with You Every Step of the Way

When you partner with The Maschhoffs, you become part of a true partnership that lets you diversify your farm's income and goes beyond a rent check. We are always looking for Production Partners who want to grow their family business.

Below is a quick overview of how The Maschhoffs work with our Production Partners:

The Maschhoffs work with each Production Partner to supply:

- Pigs from The Maschhoffs' proprietary line of genetics
- Animal care guidance, assistance and training
- Transportation
- Herd health, and veterinary support
- Ongoing support and assistance with your operation

The Maschhoffs handle the marketing and a 12-15 years production contract. Production Partners are paid monthly for usable square feet in the facility.

Production Partners provide:

- Facilities, based on standard building specs for optimal herd health and finishing
- Barns are designed to hold about 2,500 pigs
- Site requirement is between 3-5 acres
- \$1.1 - \$1.2 million investment
- Loan period typically 12-15 years
- Daily labor to manage the herd and oversee facilities

Partnering with The Maschhoffs gives you access to industry-leading research and development resources to assist you with construction, environmental services, community engagement, animal health and day-to-day pig care. In addition to income, you will also have access to manure, a fertilizer source for your grain crop. The Maschhoffs team will work with you accessing your nutrient management plan and application.

Manure Management

The manure produced from pork production reduces fertility costs and improves the soil on your crop acres.

Adding additional value to your operation

- Improves cash flow
- Offsets fertilizer costs
- Option to sell manure to other grain farmers
- Builds healthier soils
- Provides micronutrients and organic matter
- Improves water holding capacity
- Helps achieve higher crop yields



Understanding the role of manure in your operation's financial balance sheet helps drive business decisions. Based on a manure analysis from The Maschhoffs, operations can anticipate a net total value of \$36,100 on average to their farm by using available manure from a finishing barn.
